

IN GOD WE TRUST: LIFE



1 A couple weeks ago we talked about reconciliation with God and man. Read Ephesians 2:1-10. Would you say that you've been reconciled to God? Why or why not?

2 Reconciliation with God leads to reconciliation with man. Read Ephesians 2:11-22. Why should we, as Christians, care about reconciling with others?
(Read again v. 13-16, Christ died in order to bring unity and reconciliation)

3 Our world is talking a lot about racial reconciliation right now. How can this passage set a foundation for how you think about and respond to this topic?

4 At the core of many of the topics we've covered in this series is Imago Dei. Read Genesis 1:26-28. How does being made in God's image affect the way we relate to others and view all of life?

5 Another topic we discussed recently was abortion and how the world around us views life inside the womb. Read Psalm 139:13-15. According to this Scripture, when does life begin, and why is that important?

6 If you were at Wake this weekend, who remembers what the acronym SLEDD stood for? Why was this important?
(Size, Level of Development, Environment, Desirability, Dependency - none of these factors determine someone's value or worth)

7 What does it mean to be human and who determines that? How ought that impact the way that we respond to all that we've discussed in this series?
