## How Do We Parent Each Child Well?



#### 1. Pray!

Ephesians 6:18 And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.

### 2. Embrace and celebrate the differences.

<u>I Corinthians 12:12</u> Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ. 13 For we were all baptized by[c] one Spirit so as to form one body—whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free—and we were all given the one Spirit to drink. 14 Even so the body is not made up of one part but of many.

### 3. Train differently.

<u>Proverbs 22: 6</u> Train a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not turn from it.

### 4. Discipline differently when necessary.

<u>Ephesians 6:4</u> Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.
