- Read Colossians 3:23-24. How can we balance serving others and serving God?
- Do you view yourself too highly? What are some ways that you choose comfort over God? (hitting snooze instead of getting up early to pray and read your Bible, not sharing the gospel because it's a little uncomfortable, etc.)
- Read Luke 9:23. As Christians, are we called to comfort? What does Jesus command us to do if we want to follow him? (What does that mean and what action step can you take to live this out?)
- Is your view of God not high enough? Read 1 Corinthians 3:16. How should this truth change how we approach "taking up your cross"? Are you alone in it?
- Read 2 Timothy 1:6-7. What is the "gift of God in you"? How can we "fan into flame" this gift?
 (If the Spirit of God is in us, how should that impact how we live our lives?)
