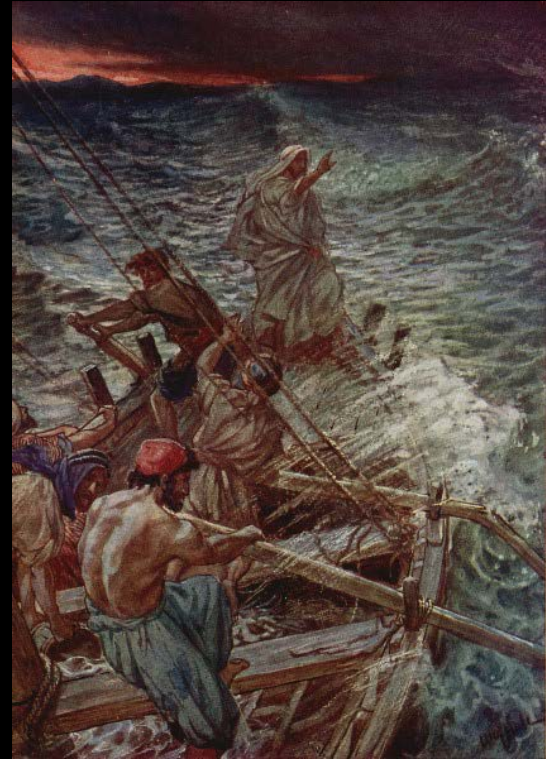
God Sends Us Thru Storms...

- Leave! Failed mission?

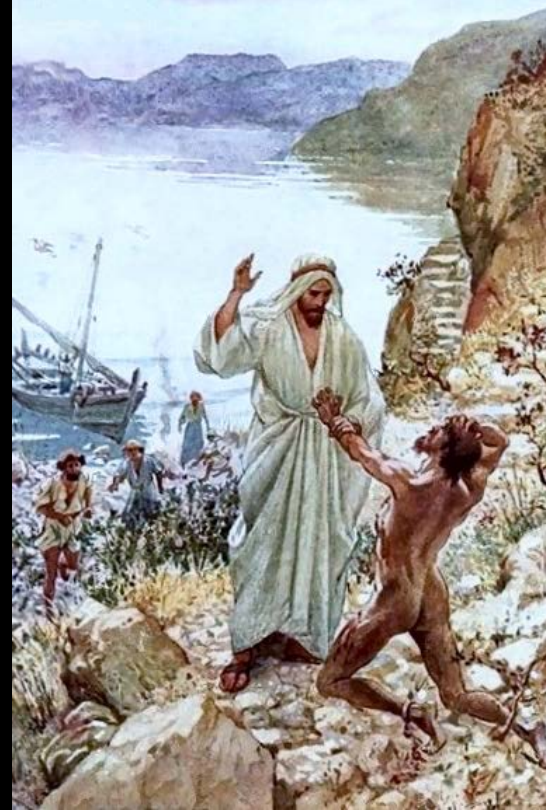




...To Reach Many. Mark 5.20
