A. Recognize That

1. It is CRITICAL to train, develop & teach your daughters

Proverbs 22:6

Train up a child in the way he should go, Even when he is old he will not depart from it.



A. Recognize That

2. Must be diligent as you invest in and disciple their potential suitors

Proverbs 21:5

The plans of the diligent *lead* surely to advantage, But everyone who is hasty *comes* surely to poverty.

3. We need to seek others help, counsel and investment in future husbands

Proverbs 24:6

And in abundance of counselors there is victory.



1. Must have a relationship with Christ

2 Corinthians 6:14

Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness?



2. Must understand God's design for marriage and role of a husband.

Ephesians 5:25-30

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church—and gave Himself up for her, so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, that He—might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no—spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless. So husbands ought also to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself; for no one ever—hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also does the church, because we are members of His body.



3. Must understand leadership of a family

Joshua 24:15

If it is disagreeable in your sight to serve the LORD, choose for yourselves today whom you will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served which were beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorities in whose land you are living; but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

4. Must be a provider & protector

1 Timothy 5:8
