Read Ephesians 2:8-9 and Titus 3:3-5. Is there anything we must do to earn the label of 'Forgiven' by God? Do you ever find yourself trying to perform for God's acceptance?

Read Romans 5:1 and 1 John 5:11-13. Do you believe that you can know for certain that you're going to Heaven?  
(We are assured Peace with God through Christ, meaning we can be 100% sure that we are going to Heaven.)

Read Ephesians 2:10. Once we are saved by grace (v.8-9), how does that impact the way that we live the rest of our lives here on Earth?
