
WHATS THE POINT? WEEK 5: SMALL GROUP

As a teenager, it can be easy to get involved in Christian activities without ever stopping to ask yourself: What is the point behind these things? The goal of this series is to help students understand the purpose behind the things they do for God.



- How does our world define greatness? (Success, popularity, fame, status) Read Mark 10:43-45, How does Jesus define greatness?
- Do you find it hard to serve others? Is it hard for you to consider others' needs before your own?
- Who is the Lord calling you to serve? Someone in your family, at work, at school, or in your community?
- Read 1 Peter 4:10: This verse tells us that we each have a gift from God. The worst thing you could do with a gift is to leave it in the box. God didn't give us our talents so we could admire them; He expects us to use them. What gifts has God given you? How could you use your gifts to serve others?
- What obstacles, fears, or doubts are keeping you from experiencing the joy of being used by God? Ephesians 3:10
- Read this quote by CT Studd "If Jesus Christ be God and died for me, then no sacrifice can be too great for me to make for Him." How can we view serving others in light of the sacrifice of Jesus?
