



 Key Principle: Parenting is all about transitions...be willing to flex both your parenting style and the expectations





- (1) Let go of your dreams/expectations and embrace God's design.
 - "And Mary said, "Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word." - Luke 1:38
 - Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid." - John 14:27



- (2) Don't compare your kids with others. The score card is "faithfulness".
- "And he also who had the two talents came forward, saying, 'Master, you delivered to me two talents; here, I have made two talents more.' His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master." Matthew 25:22-23






- (3) Maintain the relationship


- (1) Share your insights with them Identify the "positives" and the "challenges" with their wiring.








- Exposure opportunities and experiences to learn from.










