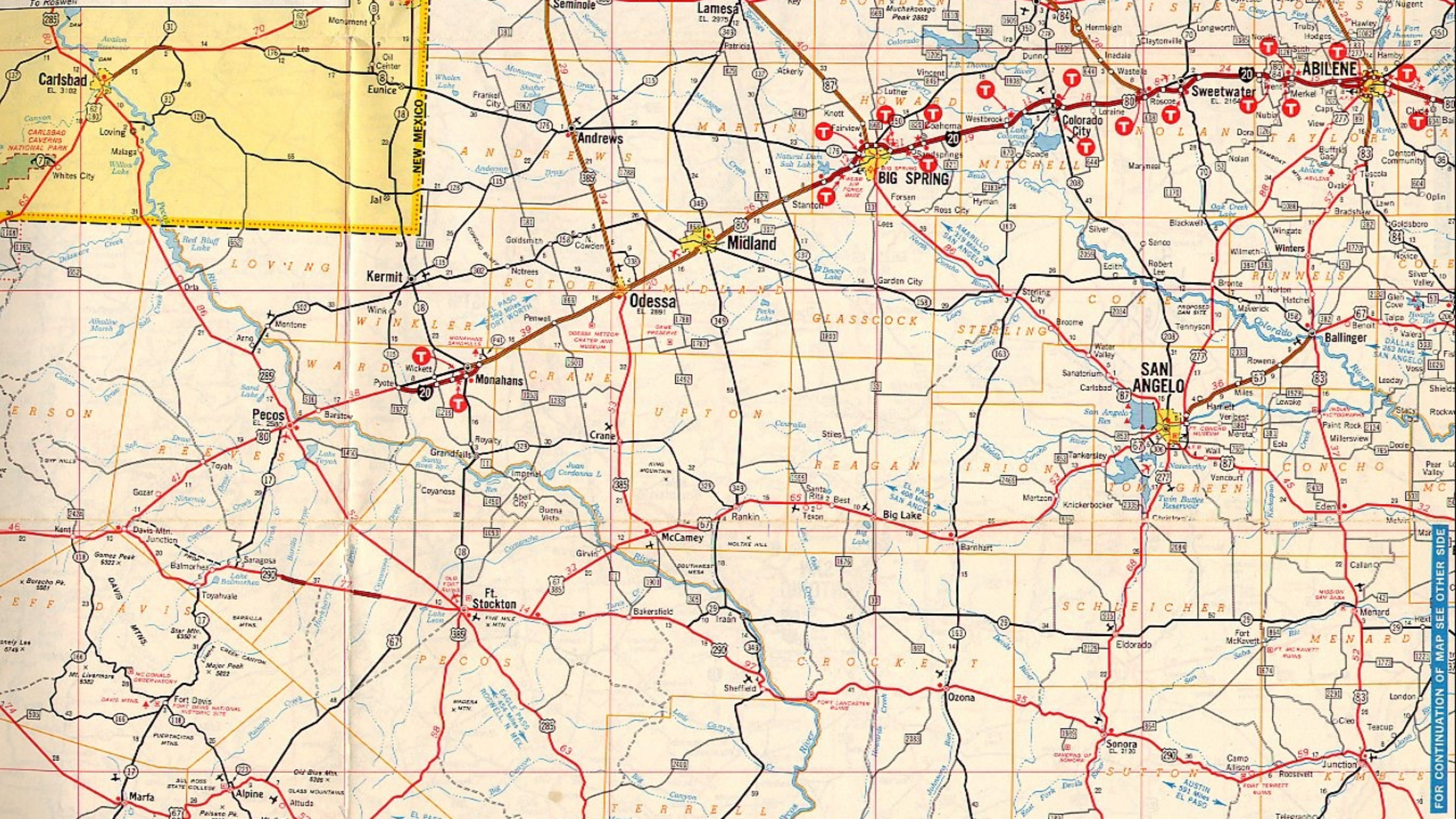

Small Group Discussion Questions
(Mark 1:14-34)
February 25, 2016

Allow each person in your group to answer one of the following questions:

- *What did you learn this week?*
 - *What are you going to do about it?*
 - *Who are you going to tell?*
1. Is there a time in your life when you repented (turned away) from your old life and placed your trust in Christ (new life)? If so, when was that? (Share your brief testimony with the group.)
 2. In what ways have you tried to be your own king? What areas of your life do you need to repent of (turn away from) and trust Christ (the true King) with? (This doesn't have to be "big sins" only. Think about things like fear, your worth, pride, etc.)
 3. How should a proper understanding and remembrance of Jesus' death on the cross and resurrection change how we live our lives?
 4. Who are the people you are praying for in the hope that God would "call them" to Himself? How does understanding and believing that the Holy Spirit does the calling change the way you share the gospel with them?
 5. Did you know about the "Top 10 List?" If so, share where you are with the top two people on your list. If not, take a few minutes in your group to identify the top two people you are praying for to come to know Christ.
 6. What is your biggest fear about following Jesus? Is there an area in your life in which you are having a hard time following Him? What are some ways to help you remind yourself that He can be trusted when you are worried or doubtful about following Him?
