- 2 Read Ecclesiastes 4:9-10: Why is it important to stay connected to others? Give an example of a time someone lifted you up in a time of need.
- Read 1 Peter 5:8: The enemy is compared to a lion. How do lions attack? How can we do a better job at protecting ourselves and one another from the attacks of the enemy? Where do you feel vulnerable to attack?
- 4 Read Ecclesiastes 4:5: This verse describes a person who is lazy and unmotivated. How does laziness affect our relationships with others? Meaningful relationships don't happen by accident.
- 5 According to Proverbs 18:1, what happens when we isolate from others?
- 6 How can your Small Group do a better job at connecting with one another?
