# The Value and Importance of Legacy

## **Ecclesiastes 7:1**

- Not physical, but a deposit in your heart a life advantage
- One can leave a good, bad, or neutral legacy

# **Legacy – Various Aspects of Leaving One**

- Life Your parents gave you life and you are giving life to the next generation.
- Intentionality What do you want it to be? Plan for it.
- Be an example of a legacy
- Faithfulness Keep renewing your calling; Living legacy
- Plan/Anticipate Think about the long range impact of your legacy



- Memories What will the next generation remember? What would you like them to remember? Write the stories.
- Tell Stories Tell them again, and again, and again
  - o Psalm 71:17-18 "O God, from my youth you have taught me, and I still proclaim your wondrous deeds. So even to old age and gray hairs, O God, do not forsake me, until I proclaim your might to another generation, your power to all those to come."
- Church/Community
- Preparing for your last days "Last words are lasting words"
- Share Desires
- Pray for your kids, grandkids, and generations you will not see
